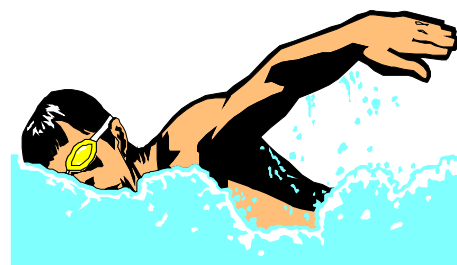

Dear Member

Our new season, will commence on Sunday the 8th October at the Sans Souci Swimming Pool, Rocky Point Road Sans Souci.



The pool has been booked from 7-30 am to 10-00 am on each Sunday morning, and we have a 30 minute allocation from 7:00am until our 7:30am to take entries, prepare the races, etc. and we would once again ask for your co-operation to be there as early as possible, so that we can commence our first race at 7-30 am. This will enable us to complete our program prior to the 10-00 am scheduled finish. The 'kiddies' pool will also be available during the hiring period, but at all times must be supervised by at least one adult. There will also be a lifesaver from BlueFit in attendance

Entry to the pool will be via the main entrance. Parking is either in the top carpark (Rocky Point Road) or at the rear of the pool and a short walk around the foreshore.

To cover our weekly hiring costs an 'NRASC Entry Fee' of \$10:00 per adult (children free), per week, will be collected from our members (Swimmers and Associate Members) and with the preferred payment method by EFT (Electronic Fund Transfer) in multiple weekly groups.

The preferred payment of fees (refer page 2) is also by EFT and payable from receipt of this notice and should be paid prior to members first swim of the season

It is also that wherever possible members also pay their Membership Fees by EFT, in both cases an accompanying email should be sent to the club to confirm your payment.

To distinguish between the two payments the following codes should be used on your transaction:

Membership Fees: MEM (Name) (Number - if paying for more than one member)

e.g. **MEM Archer 2**

Entrance Fees: ENT (Name) (Number of weeks x members)

e.g. **ENT Archer 4x2**

The Entrance Fee will be monitored throughout the year and adjusted as necessary.

Phone bookings can be made to Greg prior to Sunday. A place will be made available in each of their races but it is the responsibility of the member to be at the pool when their race is called.

New members will be required to obtain a current “Working with Children” Certificate and a copy of this Certificate will be held by the club for any future investigations. For those members with existing certificates, please make sure that your membership is current and update if necessary.

As we currently have no members available who hold a current (a) First Aid, and / or (b) Resuscitation Certificates, all First Aid matters will be dealt with by the Pool staff.

At the A.G.M., the fees for the 2023 / 2024 season were discussed at length and it was decided that they would be updated, so the fees for this season are: -

It was decided that our younger swimmers who (a) used flotation devices, were (b) accompanied by an adult, (c) swam less than 30 metres would be classed as “Recreational Swimmers”

The “Active Kids’ vouchers (*which must be spent in a single payment*) are available for children from 4½ to 18 years who currently attend school which can be used as payment for any active sport. Parents will need to register, which they can do over the internet, and they will receive a receipt that they can use as payment. “North Ramsgate Amateur Swimming Club’ is a registered provider

Please note:- A portion of your fees that are paid to NSW Swimming is for YOUR Insurance Cover, and to ensure that you maintain your coverage and protection, it is important that your fees are paid a.s.a.p. Also to comply with our Public Risk Policy all Swimmers and Officials must be insured.

We would prefer a “Single” payment to NRASC from which we will pay your Australian/NSW fees, thus ensuring that your Insurance Coverage is up-to-date.

Once again this season, on a rotation basis, we will be making available the “50 metre Relay, 20 metre Relay, 25 metre ‘Scratch’ races. And when convenient a 400 metre freestyle handicap race, with the points gained from the swim, being allocated to the normal 200 metre point score.

Whilst there are no Covid restrictions, it is suggested that members take due care whilst at the pool

Looking forward to seeing you all again, and if you know someone who may enjoy the mornings activities, please bring them along, they will be most welcome.
